Survey Concerns Discussed

were numerous There comments received from the survey how many years ago, when leaving the facility after a race meeting, traffic was split into two lanes - one for those heading Launceston way and the other for those heading towards Devonport. This season. like we would to implement the same policy as per the attached photo. We will add it to the program on race nights and the commentators will also remind people on the night.

Garbage

A common comment from respondents in the survey, was the amount of garbage that people leave on the ground and do not bother to walk to the bin. As a track, there is no way we can make people put rubbish in a bin. Garbage is a huge cost to the track – someone to put bags into bins prior to the race meeting, the cost of the bags, collection of rubbish off the ground and move it to the skip bins and then the cost of the collection of the garbage to the refuse tip. All these steps cost money and ultimately is paid for by those who attend the speedway. We have purchased wheelie bins for the coming season which are much lighter to move around and lets' hope that people see an actual garbage bin and make a little bit of an effort to place their rubbish in the appropriate place.

Race Meeting Start Time

There were a few comments regarding the time that we start our race meeting. Carrick start at 5pm as we have an extremely strict time limit of 11pm. Under no circumstances are we allowed to have cars on the track after 11pm. This is council regulation that up until only recently has not been enforced. But, it is a regulation and we must therefore abide by it. Starting at 5pm allows some leeway during the night if there are accidents which can take up considerable time or also allows for track preparation if required.
